

Significant Budget Changes and Highlights

- o The FY2022 Budget includes \$0.8 million funding for vehicles to support the Houston Police Department and \$2.8 million for vehicles to support aircraft rescue and fire fighting.
- o Includes funding to replace a significant numbers of rolling stock items that have exceeded their useful life and have high maintenance costs and poor reliability.
- o Includes funding to replace end-of-life items for technology such as network core switches and servers.
- o Includes funding to upgrade and replace Flight Information Displays at HOU as part of the SkyTrax 5-Star program.
