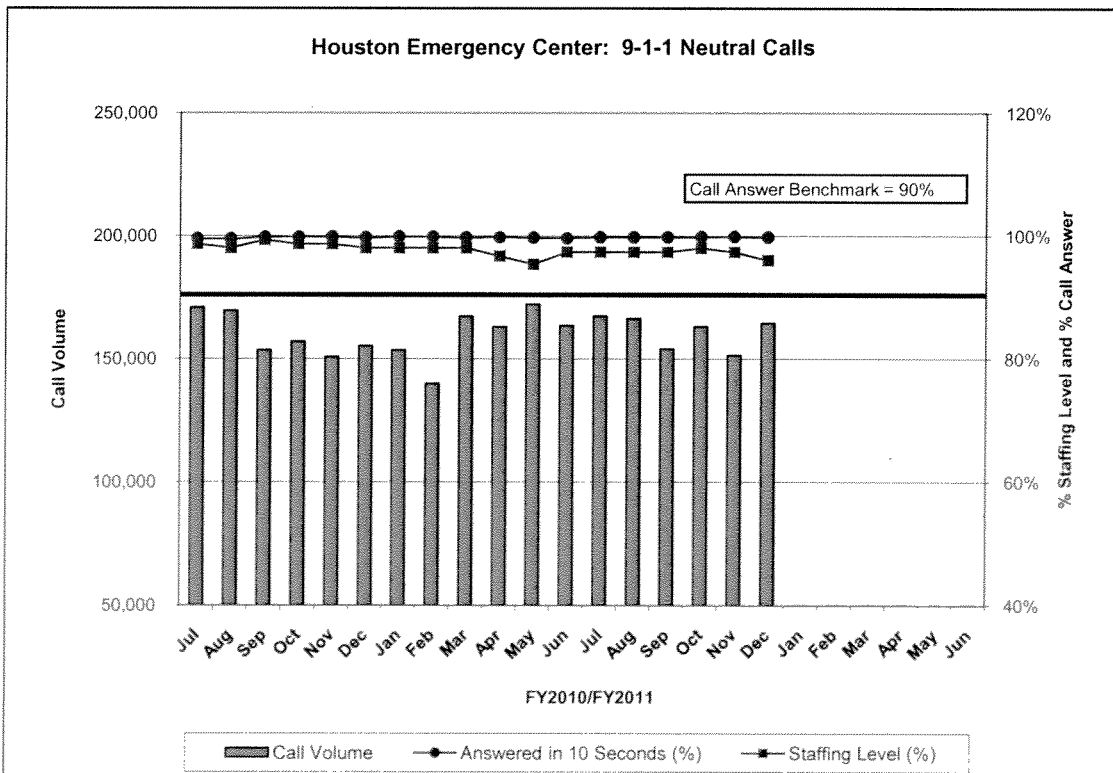
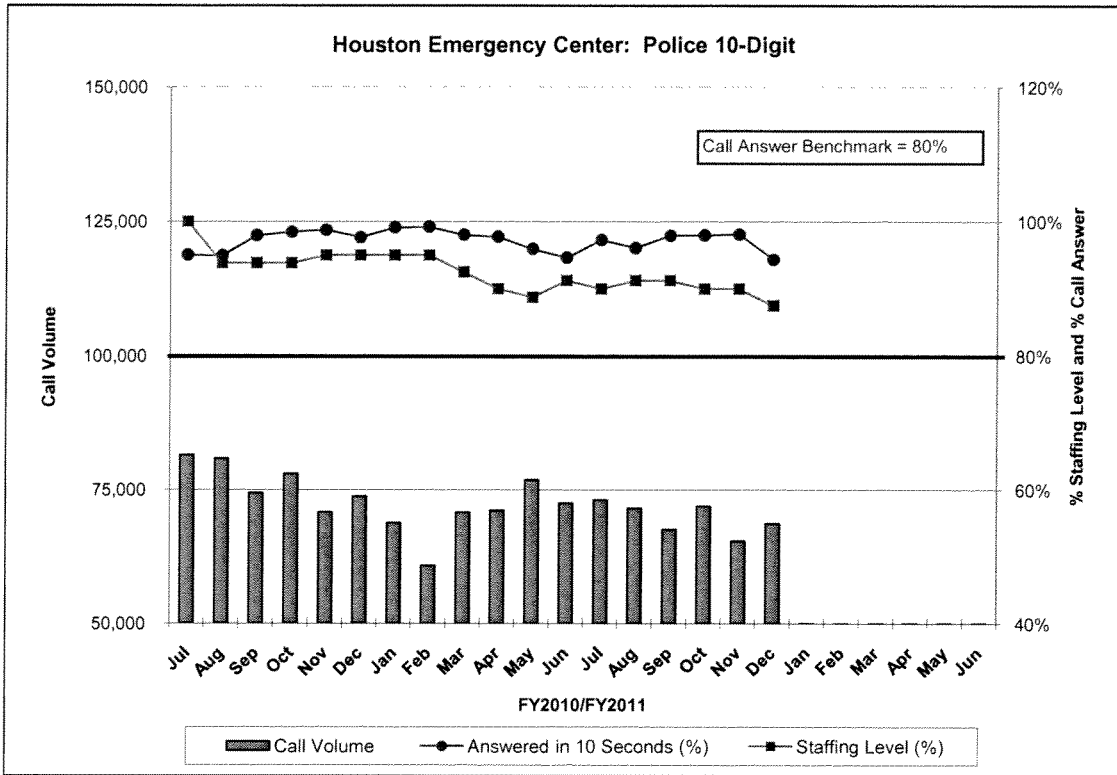
### Houston Police Department FY2011 Classified Attrition



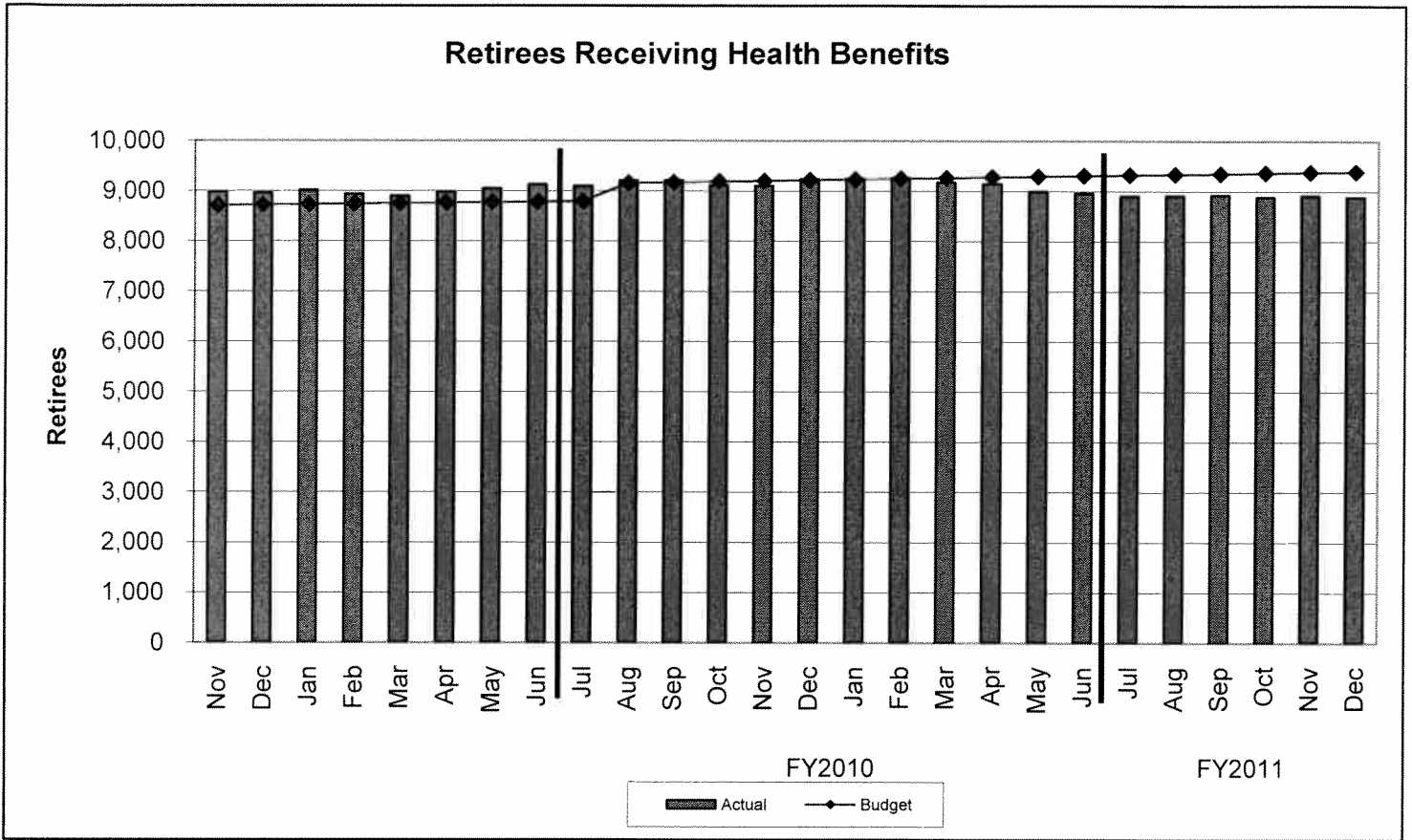
### Houston Police Department Classified Staffing - FY2009 to FY2011



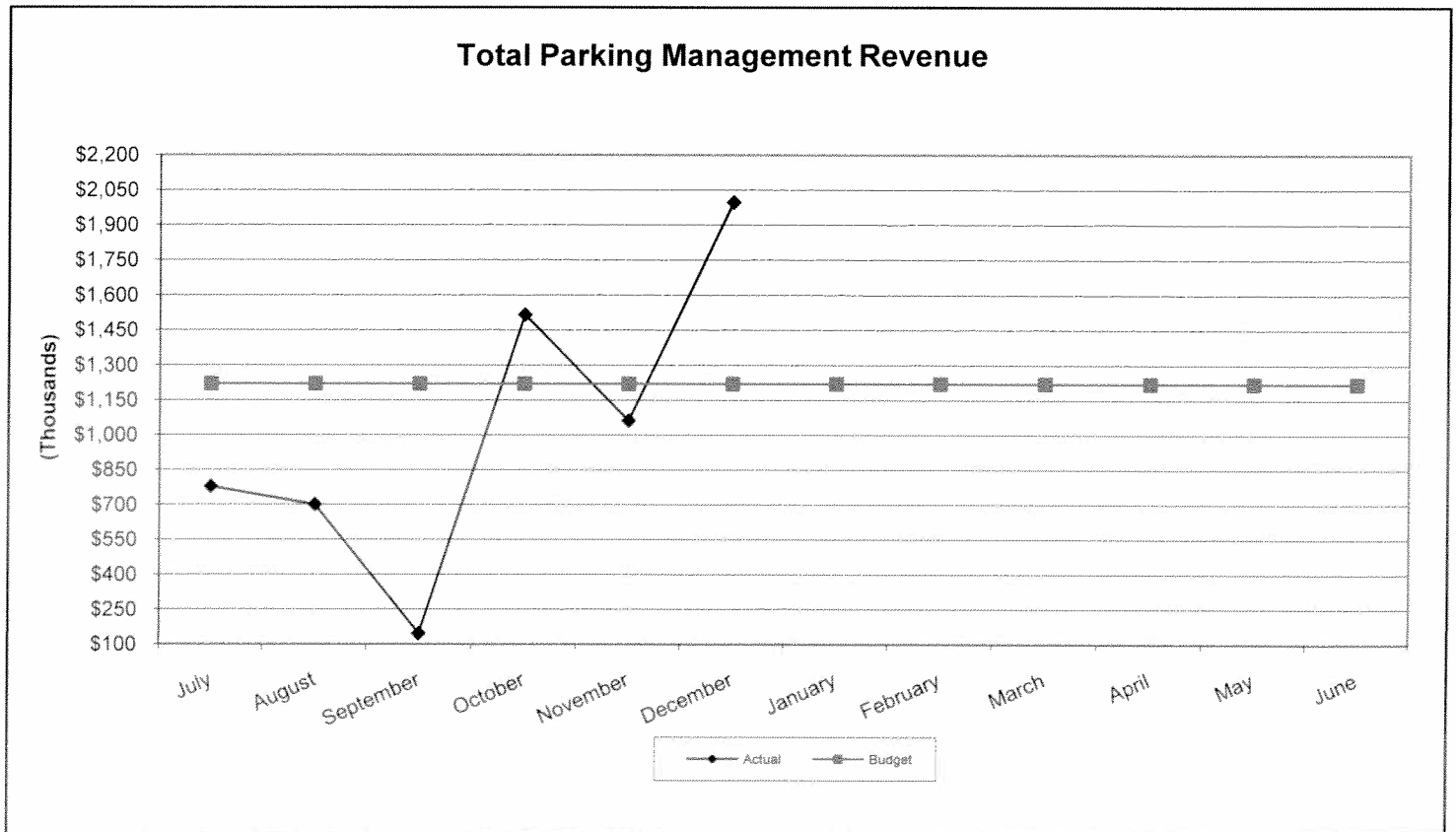
