**ORDER CANVASSING RETURNS AND
DECLARING THE RESULT OF CITY OF HOUSTON
RUNOFF ELECTION HELD DECEMBER 10, 1963**

On this the 11th day of December, 1963, the City Council of the City of Houston, being convened in regular meeting at its regular meeting place in the Council Chamber in the City Hall, with the following members present constituting a quorum:

Mayor Cutrer presiding, and Councilmen Webb,
Millers, McLemore, Swanson,
Mancuso, Hassell, Mann,
Goyen, present,

and Mr. R. H. Burks, City Attorney, and Mr. W. Lawrence Cook, Jr., First Assistant City Attorney, also present;

the City Council hereby makes the following findings, determinations and orders:

(1) The City of Houston Runoff Election for the election of officers of the City was duly and regularly called and notice thereof given, and was duly and regularly held on December 10, 1963.

(2) The returns of the election, properly certified, were made and returned in the manner required by law and are before the City Council for canvassing.

(3) The returns of such election, having been here and now examined and canvassed by the City Council in open meeting, the City Council finds and determines therefrom that a total of 123,959 persons voted at said election, and that at said election the following candidates received the number of votes indicated opposite their respective names below:

On the basis of the canvass above mentioned, the City Council finds and declares:

(a) Louie Welch received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Mayor, and was elected to that office.

(b) A. L. "Curly" Miller received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilman, District B, and was elected to that office.

(c) Homer L. Ford received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilman, District D, and was elected to that office.

(d) Bill Elliott received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilman-at-Large, Position No. 1, and was elected to that office.

(e) Frank E. Mann received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilman-at-Large, Position No. 2, and was elected to that office.

The foregoing order having been read, it was moved by Councilman Webb, seconded by Councilman Miller, that such order be adopted; and, upon the question's being called, the same was duly passed,-
