Dear Council Member Clutterbuck:


Houston Firefighters' Relief and Retirement Fund ("HFRRF") is in receipt of your letter to Christopher Gonzales concerning obtaining information and calculations for an October 5, 2010 meeting of the Budget and Fiscal Affairs Committee of City Council.

HFRRF notes that information you request concerns retirees of this fund, established under Texas Civil Statutes art. 6343e.2(1). Under section 17(a) of this article such information is "not public information under Chapter 552, Government Code." *See also, Houston Municipal Employees Pension System v. Abbott*, 192 S.W.3d 862 (Tex. App. – Texarkana 2006, writ denied).

You ask for a list of all members of HFRRF who began receiving a regular (non-disability) retirement during the 12 month period ended June 30, 2010 (but without name, years of service, dollar amounts of benefits or any other means of identifying the individual member). You ask first that the list indicate the member by age. We can perform a data manipulation to accommodate the request for a list of ages of retirees within the indicated period and it is enclosed, being only three pages of information.

The other two list elements requested are:

- -The initial annual annuity amount expressed as a % of annual base salary immediately prior to retirement (no dollar amounts)
- -The DROP account balance at retirement expressed as a multiple of annual base salary immediately prior to retirement (no dollar amounts)
