Emergency Medial Services (EMS) Fee Schedule

- PFM Consulting was selected to work with stakeholders including City Departments, Controller's Office and City Council, to develop a long-range financial plan for the City of Houston.
- Over 50 recommendations to begin addressing the City's financial challenges were made as part of the long-range financial plan released in November 2017
- The following ordinance proposals are pursuant to those recommendations



Proposed EMS Fee Schedule Changes

Increase the base rate for EMS Transport to \$1876.40

 Initiate charge at the CMS BLS rate of \$365.00 for Field Terminations

- Initiate charge of \$175.00 for Treatment-no-Transport
- Initiate charge of \$175.00 for Lift Assist calls




Last EMS Transport fee increase in 2012

Current EMS transport service fee: \$1104.65


Current EMS transport service cost: \$1876.40

- Current EMS transport fee
 - \$1104.65 plus \$14.36 per mile

- Proposed EMS transport fee
 - \$1876.40 plus \$14.36 per mile



Field Termination Fee

 At Federal level, all EMS providers are categorized as transport services

Billing Codes primarily apply to EMS transports

- CMS allows exemption for Field Termination fees
 - Current charge \$0
 - Recommendation to bill at BLS rate: \$365.00

Treatment-no-Transport Fee

- Provide therapeutic care without transport.
- Not intended for full cost recovery.
- Currently no fee
 - Recommendation: \$175.00
- CMS does not support fee. Some private insurers may reimburse.
- FY18 had nearly 30,000 responses for therapeutic care without transport.
 - Estimated collections at 15%.



Lift Assist Fee

- No therapy or care, only assistance to return the person upright or to a position of comfort.
 - Currently no fee, recommended fee of \$175.00
- Lift Assist
 - Not intended to cover "full" cost of response.
 - Create opportunity to enlighten responsible party/third party payer that the individual may need assistance/intervention.
