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Background: On November 16, 2010, a proposal was brought forward to increase the base EMS transport to \$1,000 and also retain the variable EMS mileage fee.

In an effort to bring EMS transport fees in line with the cost of service, council approved a revision to Section 4-13 that raised the base EMS transport to \$1,000. However, at the same time, the previous mileage fee was also eliminated.



Objective: To reinstate a mileage fee at \$13 per mile to offset the cost of transporting patients.

Payment Structure

Each of the different types of payers has a different structure

Loss of Revenue: All insurance programs, including Medicare and Medicaid, pay mileage as a separate item. By not charging a mileage fee, the City forfeits its right to **about \$2.7M per year**.

Taxpayer Burden: Reduces the burden on the Houston taxpayer with each reimbursement from Medicare, Medicaid, and Private Insurance which helps offset the cost of transporting a patient.
