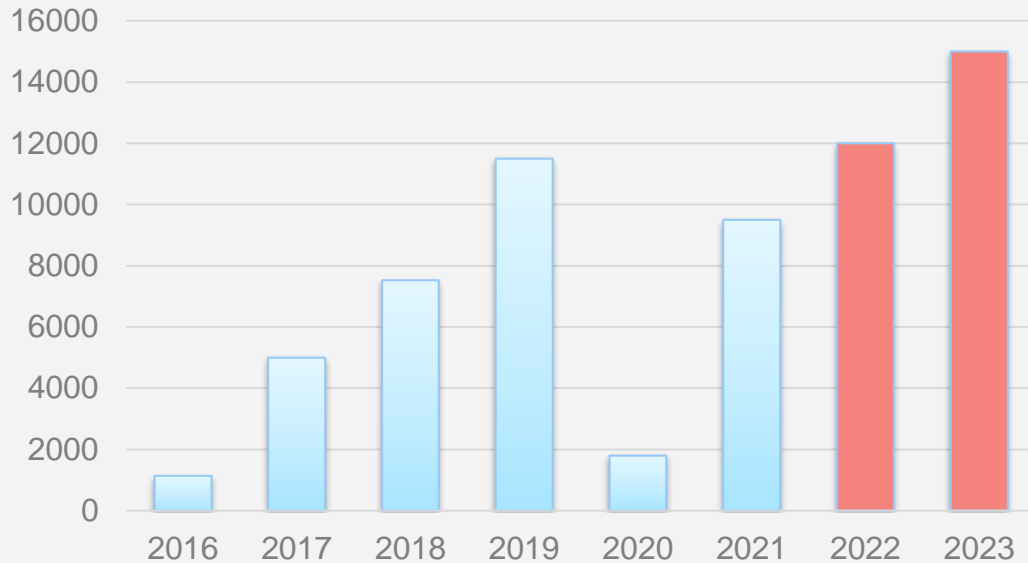

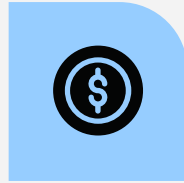

Luis Moreno, a former Hire Houston Youth intern, is now the current Community Engagement Liaison for the Mayor's Office for People with Disabilities.

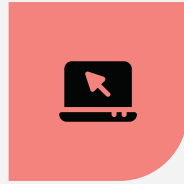
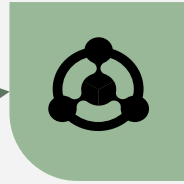
