





## Future of TechConnect

- Adoption as a City of Houston program to be embedded in HPARD ensures sustainability
- TechConnect Houston, as a COH 501(c)(3) organization can easily accept outside funding
- Plan is that the current manger will remain until end of June 2025, to facilitate the transition to the Parks Department
- 30 dedicated positions for TechConnect Interns within Hire Houston Youth



## Future of TechConnect

- There are enough resources on hand to support the operation of TechConnect at 15 sites through the summer of 2025
- While primarily a summer program, the goal is to begin hosting TechConnect Fairs throughout the academic year
