### **Community Benefits Agreement Definitions**

### Definitions: Multiple broad definitions

"CBAs are contracts between developers and...a coalition of community organizations.....for a slate of economic benefits. CBAs are a standard practice...surrounding large developments in many cities...across the country.

"A CBA is a documented bargain outlining a set of programmatic and material commitments that a private developer has made to win support from the residents of a development area....

"Usually framed as private agreements (with or without municipal involvements). CBA's may require a developer to mitigate potential impacts of the development ...asking the developer to work with the community to improve housing, employment options....

## **MOED Community Benefits Structure**


Definitions: Multiple broad definitions

- Community Benefits are required and integrated into the Tax Abatement Ordinance (2020-1091)
- Community Benefits are now negotiated with developers through the Chapter 380 agreements
- Community Benefits as part of economic or development agreements between private developers and Tax Increment Reinvestment Zones
- Community Benefit Agreement as a separate agreement from economic development agreements

The district is centrally located at the heart of innovation activity in Houston.








