




## The Existing Terminal B is undersized, outdated and cannot support United's new aircraft planned for IAH





# Three-part program includes gate modifications/additions as well as new arrivals and departures facility




Triples the capacity of the current facilities

## United is dedicated to addressing roadway congestion through sophisticated modeling efforts

#### Construction Phase Strategy:

- Prioritize a bypass lane for construction access
- Increase lane capacity around the entire building
- Explore possibilities for performing night-time construction
- Utilize offsite modular builds to minimize construction impacts on site
- Implement proactive roadway modeling throughout the construction phase




