Per the TDHCA, the funding must be used by the City on activities eliminating and/or preventing homelessness.				
Specifically, allowable activities include construction, development, or procurement of housing for homeless persons;				
rehabilitation of structures targeted to serving homeless persons or persons at-risk of homelessness; provision of direct				
services and case management to homeless persons or persons at-risk of homelessness; or other homelessness-related				
activity as approved by the TDHCA.

HHSP was established by the 81st Texas Legislature through an appropriations rider and codified during the 82nd Texas				
legislative session. Through HHSP, the state provides funding to the eight largest cities in support of services to homeless				
individuals and families including services such as case management and housing placement and retention. Cities served				
through HHSP include Arlington, Austin, Corpus Christi, Dallas, El Paso, Fort Worth, Houston and San Antonio. For State				
Fiscal Year 2017, the State has approximately \$5 million in HHSP funds available.				
This item is a procedural, administrative matter required by the State for the City to receive the funds it was previously				
awarded. An Ordinance allocating the accepted HHSP funds for use by local nonprofit organizations will be presented to				
Council for consideration within the coming weeks/months.
