Aquatics Operations Lifeguard Shortage Statistics

- 9 out of 10 park and recreation agencies experience challenges in hiring and/or retaining summer seasonal staff
- Top challenge to hiring summer seasonal staff include individuals unable to work for the entire season
- Based on past hiring trends, May is our heavy recruiting month since there are more potential candidates that apply due to the end of their school year.

SUMMER SEASONAL HIRING REPORT: KEY FINDINGS



9 in 10 park and recreation agencies experienced challenges in hiring and/or retaining summer seasonal staff

Top challenges to hiring summer seasonal staff included:

- Individuals unable to work for the entire season
- Agencies unable to match/exceed wages paid by other employers

- Phase I Weekends only
 May 25 June 11, 2024
- Phase II June 11, Tuesday through Sunday
- Closed on Mondays
- Last day for pools to be open for the season is Sunday, September 1, 2024
- We will provide an update in mid-May with the pools opening schedule
