Texas Government Code, Section 551.042. Inquiry Made at Meeting -- If at a meeting of a governmental body, a member of the public or of the governmental body inquires about a subject for which notice has not been given as required by this subchapter, the notice provisions of this subchapter do not apply to: 1) a statement off specific factual information given in response to the inquiry; or 2) a recitation of existing policy in response to the inquiry. Any deliberation of or decision about the subject of the inquiry shall be limited to a proposal to place on the agenda for subsequent meeting.
