CSMART HISTORY




- » CSMART was designed to specifically address the needs of Municipal Courts and to achieve significant improvements in speed, data integrity, user friendliness, ability to serve the citizen, increased revenue and collections, and overall efficiencies in Courts' operations
- » Design Phase was completed by COH and Sogeti in 2010
- » Development Phase started in late Summer 2010
- Delivered 23 Releases to-date (CSMART is approximately 60% feature complete)
- » Project Team is made up of COH IT and MCD internal staff and includes a mix COH contractors, and Sogeti contractors

Release Management




The process that CSMART uses to plan, design, develop, test, and ultimately accept the CSMART functionality.

- » Iterative 12 week Release cycles
- » Allows Courts to see and test features as they are built


CSMART Timeline – "Suggested"

- » Phase II Code Complete Q3/Q4 2014

CSMART Assurance Steps



- » Third party review of the plan
- » Contractual language for shared risks
- » Deliverable based, phased payment schedule, with right to cancel contract for convenience (city standard terms & conditions)
- » Regular Status Reports for City Council
- » Periodic demonstrations of product functionality to City Council Members and Staff, as requested

Recommendation



- » Move forward with Sogeti contract amendment
- » RCA for the contract amendment will contain:
 - > Finish the development in TWO phases
 - > Run and maintain (annual costs for 5 or 7 years)
 - > Total costs for both these elements
- » Target City Council Agenda 2/6/13
- » XX,XXX,XXX.00 M to finish development
- » Y,YYY,YYY.00 M to run and maintain (annual costs)
