<p>Purpose:</p>	<p>Infor Public Sector (IPS) and Enterprise Asset Management (EAM) software suites help the City manage citizen services including Utility Customer Service for water billing, various licenses, permits, inspections, and asset management.</p> <p>The City's existing Master Agreement is nearing the end of the 3-year base contract term. This is an opportunity to combine all separate Infor agreements into a single Enterprise Master Agreement with more favorable terms, and authorize professional services to continue to expand usage of Infor and eliminate legacy systems.</p>

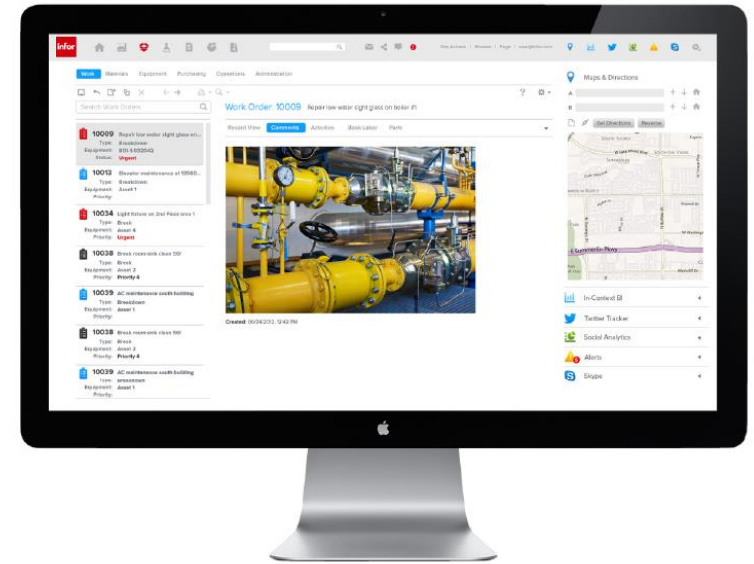

What it does





Infor EAM Enterprise provides the tools to enable **predictive maintenance (PdM)** and **condition-based maintenance (CBM)**, along with intelligent operations and asset sustainability capabilities. It delivers equipment alarms, as well as the data dashboards and real-time intelligence needed to take quick action and escalate problems.







EAM includes, but is not limited to:

- **Asset hierarchy management.** Keep track of where your assets are located and what they cost with the help of a "family tree" that connects equipment, systems, and locations.
- **Inspection management.** Get automatic notification of an asset problem when an inspection exceeds a preset limit, and find out how to fix it.
- **Work management.** Track and manage all asset work requests, labor, planning, and scheduling.
- **Materials management.** Monitor and control storeroom inventories with tools that include economic order quantity with class calculations and assignments, support parts receipts, issues, returns, and cycle counts.

This represents additional savings by eliminating other contracts beyond Infor contract discounts negotiated

Highlights of the proposed NEW contract ... by the numbers

- Eliminated dispute of duplicative licenses – resulted in savings of **\$2,220,590** over projected 7 year agreement. **18% savings overall**
- Maintenance & support cost escalation limited to **2% per year**. That's 1% below Gartner's estimated lowest percentage, and significantly improved from the 6% PWE is paying today.
- The City's maintenance and support payments for the next 7 years will be less than what we are paying today... from the contract discounts alone. This does not count the additional savings forecasted by eliminating other software contract support maintenance costs.
- **25% discount** of Elite level support costs.
