#### **Enterprise Infrastructure Managed Services Agreement**

#### **Data Center Operation Services**

Supports the monitoring, maintenance, and management of services for the City's core enterprise data centers. This includes HVAC, mechanical and electrical service / support, and on-call as needed support.

#### Server, Storage, and Backup Services

- Consulting services including design and engineering for servers, storage, and data backup services.
- Project Management and Implementation services
- Patch management (including endpoints)

#### **Network Services**

- On call tier II and tier III services to support ad hoc projects (both operational and capital) in support of the City of Houston's stabilization and strategic efforts.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> shift on-call monitoring and support.

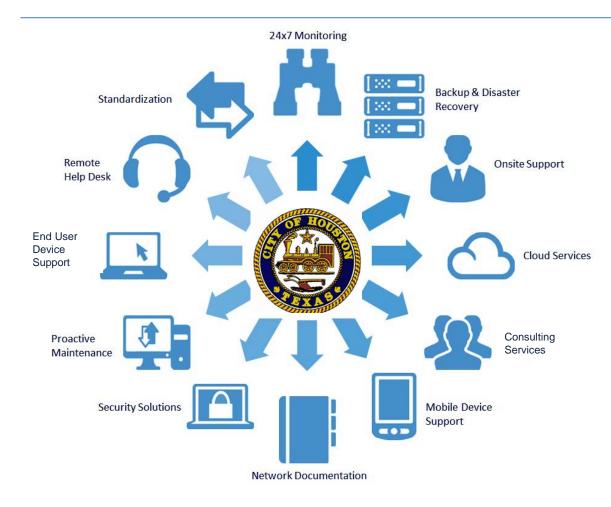
#### **End User Support Services**
