- ➤ 6,195 miles of pipes

DRINKING WATER SYSTEM

- ❖ 3 Surface Water Treatment Facilities
- 100 Groundwater Wells
- > 7,144 miles of pipes
- Facility assessments are currently under contract.





Total = **\$17.2M**




