REQUIRED WATER CONSERVATION PLAN

- Texas Commission on Environmental Quality &
- Texas Water Development Board
- all cities with 3,300+ connections
- Texas Administrative Code Title 30, Chapter 288



REQUIRED WATER CONSERVATION PLAN

- update every 5 years
- 2009, 2014 and 2019
- specific content
- council approval



PLAN GOALS

- reduce water demand/consumption
- improve water-efficiency
- reduce water loss & water waste
- increase water reuse & recycling
- incorporate plan for drought

- 5 & 10 year targets

DROUGHT CONTINGENCY PLAN - NO UPDATES

| PARTICIPATION | voluntary | mandatory | mandatory | mandatory |
| OUTDOOR WATERING RESTRICTION | 2x week | 2x week | none allowed | none allowed |




2018 HOUSTON RETAIL WATER CUSTOMERS

IMPLEMENTATION

Water Main Replacement Program

- CIP investment (2019-2023)
- \$890M water transmission
- \$110M water distribution

Water Loss Program

- more accurate metering practices
- improved record-keeping standards
- improved infrastructure

Consumption Awareness Program

- Automated Metering Infrastructure provides real time customer interface

Water Conservation Team

- expand the Water Conservation Program
- coordinate efforts with internal, local and regional stakeholders

American Water Works Association Benchmarking Tool

compares Houston to other utilities

Water Conservation Dashboard

- for City and wholesalers
- identify real and hypothetical water savings
- future request for council approval



PUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAMS

WaterWorks Education Center

- located at Northeast Water Purification Plant
- 31,043 visitors (2014-2018)

School Education Program

- host Institution of Project WET curriculum
- certified more than 300 educators
- 25 school districts, 47 private schools, 8 colleges and 60+ home school students

Annual WaterWorks Festival

- 10,464 attendees (2014-2018)
