### **ROAD SAFETY AUDIT HISTORY**

**Mayor Turner** promised the community that Houston Public Works would look at the 10 most dangerous intersections for bicycles and pedestrians to see what improvements could be made.

**Houston Public Works** reached out to Bike Houston and LINK Houston for inputs on the 10 locations. The three parties met and 12 intersections were selected.

Houston Public Works coordinated with the Federal Highway Administration to receive technical assistance on Road Safety Audits.



- Form Audit Team: Federal Highway Administration, Houston Public Works, Houston Police Department, Houston Metro, Planning & Development Department, Bike Houston, LINK Houston, TxDOT
- 2 Audit Team inspected each site



Bellaire Blvd & South Gessner Rd	adjust/modify bus stops/shelters
Fannin St & Pierce St	future capital project/bulb outs & lane assignments
Washington Ave & Patterson St	funds available / seeking public input



#### short-term


- signal maintenance

## FONDREN RD & WEST BELLFORT AVE

#### short-term


- add time to pedestrian signal
- refresh crosswalk

## long-term

- add bike lanes on Fondren
- adjust bus stop placements


- crosswalk markings

- signal timing
- improve driveway crossings

rebuild trail corner



## **FUTURE OF THE ROAD SAFETY AUDIT PROGRAM**

**Vision Zero** is an international movement that acknowledges that all roadway deaths are preventable with improved street design, education and enforcement.

**Mayor Turner** signed an executive order on August 14<sup>th</sup> setting a goal of eliminating all roadway related fatalities in Houston by 2030.

The Road Safety Audit Program will become a key component of the Vision Zero effort as the City continues to systematically look at problem intersections.

Houston Public Works will work with other agencies such as TxDOT. Metro and Harris County to evaluate shared intersections.
