

#### **FMA HOME ELEVATION PROGRAM**


#### **Purpose and benefits**

- Reduce or eliminate risk of repetitive flood loss
- Elevate to current floodplain Ordinance (Chapter 19)
- Keep neighborhoods intact
- Voluntary participation


#### Requirements

- Active National Flood Insurance Program policy
- Must maintain insurance in perpetuity
- Must meet FEMA Benefit Cost requirement




#### **FMA PROGRAM COST SHARE**



# PROPOSAL TO EXPEDITE HOMEOWNER AGREEMENTS

#### **OBJECTIVE**

Expedite start of construction and return homeowners to homes faster

#### CHALLENGE

Number of agreements requiring City approval

#### PROPOSED ACTION

Delegate authority to Mayor to execute Homeowner and Escrow Agreements

#### **PROPOSED ORDINANCES**

#### **Existing grants:**

Single ordinance approving "as-to-form" agreements for each grant and authorizing Director and Mayor to execute homeowner and escrow agreements, with not-to-exceed grant authorization amounts matching the awarded grants.

#### **Future Grants:**

Future grant agreement acceptance ordinances to include "as-to-form" templates and language authorizing Director and Mayor to execute homeowner and escrow agreements, with not-to-exceed grant authorization amounts matching the awarded grant.

#### **Both Cases:**

CMs would be notified by memo when homeowner contracts are executed to maintain transparency.
