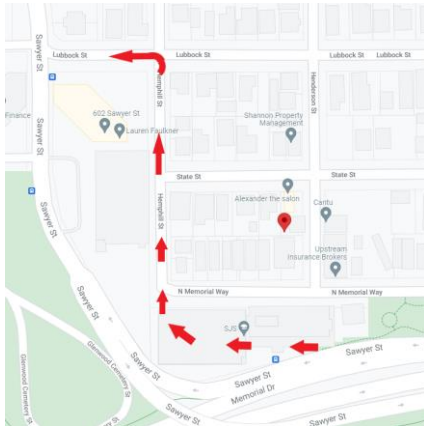

HAULING OF DEBRIS & TRAFFIC FLOW | JANUARY 24th, 2021



This week BLOCK has commenced the second phase of Demolition and will be hauling off any debris material from the site. BLOCK's Demolition Company, Cherry, will initially be utilizing (3) hauling trucks, possibly building up to (10) trucks by the end of the week. These trucks will be staged off-site and will move to the site as needed. The trucks will utilize the closed protected lane along Memorial Way and as trucks ingress and egress, Cherry will have flaggers and spotters directing traffic.

The hauling trucks will go north on Hemphill and then west on Lubbock to access Sawyer (see image below). Please keep in mind that if for any reason Lubbock isn't accessible (i.e., parked cars too close to the corner for the trucks to turn) there may be times when Cherry will have to deviate from the plan as outlined above and use the first available street going west to access Sawyer.



Our goal for the hauling of debris is to have as minimal impact to the neighborhood as possible. Our overall Traffic Flow Plan for the 2100 Memorial jobsite and the surrounding neighborhood, is to ease congestion for the residents and to be mindful of the historic nature of the community. Just know, at BLOCK we have identified the best routes to not only be efficient in the management of the demolition on the jobsite and the hauling of debris but to also reduce the number of trucks that will travel through the neighborhood.

BLOCK anticipates that the hauling of debris will be completed by March 1st, 2022.
