



I. DEED RESTRICTION OVERVIEW

What Are Deed Restrictions?

- Private, contractual covenants which limit land use
- Two types: real and personal
 - Real covenants run with the land, binding all future owners
 - Personal covenants benefit a specific party, and any permitted assignee
 - Presumption for personal covenants






















Public safety is a key initiative of Council Member Green and the Brentwood/Pamela Heights community. There will be an open Q&A portion at the end of the meeting.






