FAILURE TO ANSWER SUMMONS AND PENALTIES

A person summoned for jury service who does not comply with the summons as required by law or who knowingly provides false information in a request for an exemption or to be excused from jury service is subject to a contempt action punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000. (Govt Code/Section 62.0141). Additionally, a juror lawfully notified shall be fined not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000. (Govt Code/Section 62.0141). Additionally, a juror lawfully notified shall be fined not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 if the juror: (1) fails to attend court in obedience to the notice without reasonable excuse; or (2) files a false claim of exemption from jury service (Govt Code, Section 62.111).

Right to Reemployment (Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Section 122.001):

An employer may not discharge, threaten to discharge, intimidate, or coerce any permanent employee because the employee serves as a juror, or for the employee's attendance or scheduled attendance in connection with the service, in any court in the United States. An employee who is discharged, threatened with discharge, intimidated, or coerced in violation of this section is entitled to return to the same employment that the employee held when summoned for jury service if the employee, as soon as practical after release from jury service, gives the employer actual notice that the employee intends to return.
