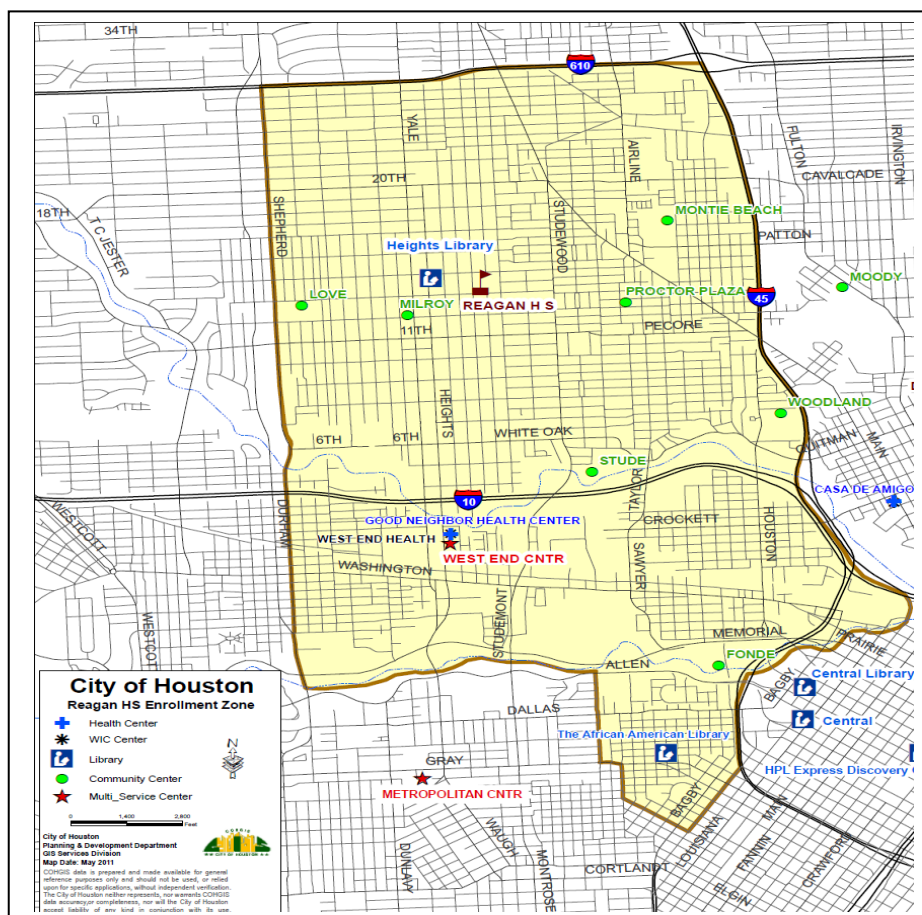

SERVICES AVAILABLE:

Community Centers –

Available to public for social, cultural, educational, health and recreational activities. These activities include but not limited to: arts and crafts, games, dance classes, community meetings, summer enrichment camps, computer training, and athletics, and more.

Health Centers – Provides prenatal/maternity care, immunizations, dental care, health and nutritional information and care.

Multi-Service Centers –

Provides nutritional, health and wellness, mental health, social, education, recreational and public safety services.

Neighborhood Libraries –

Provides free access to print and electronic media, music and internet. Programs include free tutoring, SAT test prep, reading clubs and early childhood literacy as well as classes in technology, language and financial literacy.

WIC Program Centers -

Services for middle to low-income women, infants, and children up to age 5 include providing free prenatal/postpartum nutrition education, nutritional foods, counseling, and health care referrals.
