Safety Tip:



If you attempt to extinguish the fire, it is best to use a class ABC multipurpose fire extinguisher. Follow the manufacturers instructions - stay back 6 to 8 feet and be careful not to spray the grease out of the pan.

Baking soda can also smother the fire. If the fire has not burned for more than fifteen seconds, it may still be possible to turn the burner off and use a tight fitting lid to smother the fire, but only if the fire is still small and has not spread beyond the pan.

Barbeque Grill Safety Tips

When igniting the bbq charcoal, use a charcoal lighter, not gasoline. A fire extinguisher or charged garden hose should be handy. Check the pit frequently .

Hot ash and coals from bbq pits and charcoal burners should be placed in a non-combustible container until cooled or thoroughly saturated with water, before being disposed of.



Safety Tip: Holiday Lights

Don't use any more than 3 strands on a run (follow manufactures instructions).
