Project Description: This project will be a complete interior remodel of the existing Fire Station #19. The renovation will include approximately 10,516 total square feet. It will consist of selective demolition, new Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing, Low Voltage systems, removal and replacement of the entire roof, a complete interior buildout with new finishes and site improvements, removal of existing masonry and masonry furring, foundation remediation repairs. The three (3) apparatus bays of the fire station are expected to be fully operational throughout the entire renovation. All construction will need to be compliant with all jurisdictional requirements.
