Project Description: The Memorial to San Felipe Hike & Bike Connection (Project) is funded through an Advanced Funding Agreement (AFA) for a Transportation Alternatives Project (TAP) between the State of Texas, acting through the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT) and the City of Houston (COH) acting through the Houston Parks and Recreation Department (HPARD). This project will be managed by the General Services Department (GSD). This AFA was approved and completed with initial programming in November 2016. The program features include a new ten (10) foot wide concrete shared-use path from Memorial Dr. to San Felipe, a new pedestrian bridge across Buffalo Bayou with structural abutments, overhead canopy at railroad crossing, pedestrian railing, site amenities and landscaping.
