(One of the projects at Sylvan Rodriguez Park was made possible by a grant under the coastal zone management act of 1972, as amended, and awarded by the Office of Ocean and Atmospheric Administration, U.S. Department of Commerce, and approved by the Texas Land Commissioner and the Texas Coastal Management Program. A total of 60% of the total cost of this project will be financed with federal money, totaling \$160,202. A total of 40% of the project cost will be financed by the City of Houston, totaling \$106,801).
