

Trash Bash Clean-Up on April 2

HHD's Bureau of Pollution Control and Prevention (BPCP) partnered with the Galveston Bay Estuary Program, Lawyers Against Waste (L.A.W.) and the Houston-Galveston Area Council to coordinate the annual Trash Bash Clean-Up at Mason Park in SE Houston (satellite sites on Kuhlman Gully and Brays Bayou near the Houston Ship Channel).
