

PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Houston (City), through its Housing and Community Development Department (HCDD), is inviting contractors to submit proposals to participate in its Single Family Reconstruction Program Disaster Recovery Services, funded under the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR). As of July 1, 2011 the Texas General Land Office (GLO) oversees the administration and funding through a contract entered into by and between the City and the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA). Single Family houses being reconstructed under this initiative are those homes damaged during the United States President-declared Major Disaster Hurricane Ike (FEMA-DR-1791).

The contract with the State of Texas provides that a percentage of reconstruction and rehabilitation homes are to be demolished and reconstructed. The housing reconstruction scope of work under this specific RFP will cover up to forty (40) individual contracts providing both the demolition of the existing structure and construction of a new single family house on the existing property site.

A copy of the RFP is available for download from HCDD's Web site at www.houstonhousing.org. It is the responsibility of each contractor/or contractors to electronically generate and examine the entire RFP, seek clarification in writing, and review their submittal for accuracy before submitting questions relating to the RFP. Questions must be submitted in writing and directed to Derrick McClendon, via email Derrick.McClendon@HoustonTx.gov.

The deadline for submission of questions relating to this RFP is 5:00 p.m., Friday, March 2, 2012. All questions submitted in writing prior to the deadline will be compiled and answered in writing. Once the submission of question deadline has passed, all submissions will be final. A copy of all questions and answers will be posted as Letter of Clarification on City of Houston Housing & Community Development Web site, www.houstonhousing.org. HCDD will not be bound by any information conveyed verbally. Submission of RFP proposals will be received until 2:00 p.m. Tuesday, March 9, 2012, at the City Secretary's Office, City Hall Annex, Public Level, 900 Bagby Street, Houston, TX 77002.
