Important Updates



- The way you access information and enroll for 2024 Medicare Advantage plans will be different. As part of HROne, Human Resources is implementing Benefitplace, which will simplify and optimize your retiree benefits enrollment and maintenance experience by providing mobile-friendly online access to enroll or make changes.
- Except for moving outside the network area, beginning January 1,2024, you will **NO LONGER** be able to change plans until November 2024 which will have a January 1, 2025 effective date.
- If you are already enrolled in a City of Houston Medicare Advantage Plan and you are happy with it, you do not need to do anything to remain enrolled.

New for 2024



Aetna Basic and Premiere PPO Additional Benefits

Eligibility



As a retiree, you are eligible for coverage on one of the City of Houston's Medicare Advantage Plans if:

- You are Medicare eligible
- You are covered by Medicare Parts A and B
- You were covered by a City of Houston medical plan on Jan. 1, 2010, and filed paperwork to opt out of a city plan



- On the Premier plan, because this is a PPO ESA plan, your copays or cost share amounts are the same for any doctor or hospital according to the costs listed on your plan benefits summary.



- Log on to Benefitplace
 - benefitplace.houstontx.gov
- Access, complete and sign a fillable PDF Medicare Advantage Enrollment Form
 - CityofHoustonBenefits.org
- Return completed Medicare Advantage Enrollment Form
 - Enrollment forms must be submitted by November 27, 2023 (end of open enrollment).
 - Open enrollment changes become effective January 1, 2024
- Submit supporting documentation for your enrollment
 - Ex: Copy of your marriage certificate (if you are adding a new spouse)
 - Ex: Copy of your Medicare Parts A and B card (for you, your spouse and/or dependent enrollees)
