### **GENERAL SUMMARY:**

Assists the lead treatment plant operator in maintaining and performing routine activities, while learning the treatment processes and plant equipment.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Assists in maintaining plant compliance with State and Federal permits.
- Performs general cleaning of grounds and buildings, including removing debris from various mechanical systems.
- Ensures plant safety and sanitary requirements:
  - Washes down plant
  - Maintains plant grounds, i.e. collects litter
  - Cleans clarifiers, blower filters, rotor screens, etc.
- Maintains a daily log of calls, reports and messages.
- May be assigned to a control center or plant control room for monitoring of multiple systems.
- Performs other duties as requested.

# **SPECIFICATIONS:**

#### KNOWLEDGE:

Requires a high school diploma or a GED certificate. Requires a valid Texas driver's license and compliance with the City of Houston's policy on driving.

### **EXPERIENCE:**

No experience is required.

Certification: Within one year of entry into classification, must obtain a Texas Class "D" Water/Wastewater

Operator's certificate. Must obtain a Texas Class "C" Water/Wastewater Operator's certificate appropriate to position location, such as surface water, groundwater, distribution,

maintenance wastewater plant or wastewater, within two years after obtaining "D"

certification.

### **COMPLEXITY:**

Work consists of routine standard procedures and tasks where simple analytical ability is required to select and execute actions.

#### **IMPACT OF ACTIONS:**

Errors in work typically lead to minor inconvenience and costs. Work is typically performed under close supervision of simple routine duties to ensure completion; or tasks are so highly routine that they may simply require following standardized instructions without continuous direct supervisory observation.

### **CONTACTS:**

#### **Internal Contacts:**

#### **External Contacts:**

Level of external contact is extremely infrequent with virtually no outside contact. Interaction involves routine information exchange and/or simple service activity that requires common courtesy; e.g., directing calls and answering simple questions.

# **PHYSICAL EFFORT:**

The position involves considerable physical exertion, such as regular climbing of ladders, lifting of heavy objects (up to 80 pounds) on a highly frequent basis and/or assuming awkward positions for long periods of time.

### WORK ENVIRONMENT:

There are frequent exposures to extreme levels of temperature, air pollution, noise pollution, chemical gases and substances, and/or contagious diseases or physical trauma conditions of a short-term disabling nature, such as broken bones or temporary loss of sight or hearing.

#### **PHYSICAL SKILL:**

Requires the ability to make coordinated gross motor movements in response to changing external stimuli within moderately demanding tolerances; or the ability to make coordinated eye/hand movements on a patterned response space within low tolerance demands with no real speed requirements.
