GENERAL SUMMARY:

Performs a wide range of specialized technical environmental health inspections of public and private establishments, locations, and vehicles to ensure compliance with local state, and federal health ordinances, statutes and regulations.

RESPONSIBILITES:

- Inspects various establishments or locations (e.g., retail and food service establishments, institutions, aquatic facilities, apartment, laundromats, sewage and water systems, vehicles, private residences, etc. to detect possible health code violations.
- Collects food, water, waste water, dairy and other laboratory samples for analysis.
 - Performs enforcement actions such as condemns unsafe food; quarantines food and equipment enforce closures, issues citations and notices of violations.
- Identifies specialized processes and verifies Variance and Hazard Analysis Critical Control Point (HACCP) plans approved by the department.
- Investigates community health complaints, such as sewage overflows, storm water, foodborne
 illness, illegal dumping, swimming pools, and reports of poor sanitation in public establishments or
 private property, explains local, state and federal health ordinances, statutes, regulations, and
 recommends corrective action, performs follow-up inspections, issues warnings or citations.
- May appear in court to testify regarding violations; provides evidence in enforcement hearings.
- May conduct food managers' certification courses, public outreach presentations, continuing education presentations, department-wide initiatives, and other community related outreach.
- May review architectural blue prints of new food establishments for compliance with City health ordinances and conduct pre-opening inspections.

SPECIFICATIONS:

KNOWLEDGE:

A Bachelor's degree which must include 30 semester hours of basic or applied science courses, is required.

EXPERIENCE:

One year of experience in a related environmental health field is required.

License: A State of Texas Sanitarian-in-training or Registered Sanitarian Certificate is required

or proof of successful completion of registration exam.

A valid Texas driver's license and compliance with the City of Houston's policy (A.P. 2-2) on

driving is required.

SPECIFICATIONS: (continued)

COMPLEXITY:

Work consists of standard procedures and tasks where analytic ability is required in following guidelines, policies and precedents.

IMPACT OF ACTIONS:

Errors in work typically lead to minor inconvenience and costs. Work is typically performed under moderate to limited supervision with standard operating procedures. The incumbent functions under general review and at times autonomously, with the supervisor available to answer more difficult questions.

Direct Supervision:

No direct report employees.

Indirect Supervision:

CONTACTS:

Internal Contacts:

Level of internal contact is primarily with professionals and supervisors. Interaction involves information exchange and/or service activity requiring moderate tact and cooperation.

External Contacts:

Level of external contact is primarily with citizens, owners, operators, visitors and/or mid-level representatives of government agencies, guests, vendors and professional contacts with allied organizations. Interaction requires moderate tact and cooperation; e.g., responding to questions which require some research to provide the correct answer.

PHYSICAL EFFORT:

This position routinely requires lifting of moderately heavy items such as manhole covers (up to 40 pounds) may be required.

WORK ENVIRONMENT:

There are routine discomforts from exposure to moderate heat, cold, moisture/wetness and unpleasant air conditions and odors. The position may involve routine exposure to soiled materials and light chemical substances such as cleaning solutions. This position may also be exposed to tight spaces such as mobile food units, walk in coolers and storage rooms.

PHYSICAL SKILL:

Requires the ability to make coordinated gross motor movements in response to changing external stimuli within moderately demanding tolerances; or the ability to make coordinated eye/hand movements on a patterned response space within low tolerance demands with no real speed requirements.
