Job Title: SANITARIAN III

GENERAL SUMMARY:

Performs a wide range of specialized and highly technical environmental health inspections of public and private establishments and locations, and vehicles to ensure compliance with City, State, and Federal health ordinances, statutes and regulations.

RESPONSIBILITES:

- Inspects various establishments or locations to detect possible health code violations. Identifies specialized processes and verifies Variance and Hazard Analysis Critical Control Point (HACCP) plans approved by the department.
- Investigates community health complaints, such as sewage overflows, storm water, foodborne illness, illegal dumping, aquatic facilities, and reports of poor sanitation in public establishments or private property, explains City, State and Federal Health ordinances, statutes, regulations, and recommends corrective action, performs follow-up inspections, issues warnings or citations.
- May perform and coordinate efforts for disaster and emergency response actions, including monitoring shelters Create new accounts for new establishments and change of ownership of establishments
- Trains less experienced Sanitarian and serve as section lead in the absence of Sanitarian IV.
- Reviews architectural blue prints of new establishments for compliance with City health ordinances and conduct pre-opening inspections.
- Conduct educational services such as food managers' certification courses, public outreach
 presentations, continuing education presentations, department-wide initiatives, and other community
 related outreach.
- Act as a lead on high priority public health investigations, such as large foodborne illness investigations, major clean water violation cases, and other case developments.
- Coordinates training of new employees and offer feedback, guidance and support while in the field.

SPECIFICATIONS:

KNOWLEDGE:

A Bachelor's degree including 30 semester hours in basic or applied science courses, is required.

EXPERIENCE:

Three years of experience in a related environmental health field, are required.

License: A State of Texas Registered Sanitarian Certificate is required.

A valid Texas driver's license and compliance with the City of Houston's policy AP 2-2 on

assignment and use of vehicles is required.

Substitution: No substitutions for education, experience or certification.

COMPLEXITY:

Work requires the direct application of a variety of procedures, policies and/or precedents. Moderate analytic ability is required in applying guidelines, policies and procedures, and in adapting standard methods to fit facts and conditions.

IMPACT OF ACTIONS:

Errors in work lead to some inconvenience and inconvenience. Work is typically performed under limited supervision with alternating periods of relative autonomy and general review. The supervisor generally plays a substantial role in setting objectives and organizing work.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED:

Direct Supervision:

May occasionally lead or provide work direction for others.

Indirect Supervision:

No indirect reports.

CONTACTS:

Internal Contacts:

Level of internal contact is primarily with professionals and supervisors. Interaction requires tact and cooperation; e.g., scheduling, coordinating, resolving problems and/or obtaining necessary information.

External Contacts:

Level of external contact is primarily with citizens, owners, operators, visitors and/or mid-level representatives of government agencies, guests, vendors and professional contacts with allied organizations. Interaction requires considerable tact and cooperation involving somewhat sensitive issues or problems

PHYSICAL EFFORT:

The position requires stooping or bending, climbing stairs or steps. Some lifting, such as three or four reams of papers or books, manhole covers using appropriate tools (up to 40 pounds or an equivalent weight) may be required.

WORK ENVIRONMENT:

There are routine discomforts from exposure to moderate heat, smoke, cold, moisture/wetness and unpleasant air conditions and odors. The position may involve routine exposure to soiled materials and light chemical substances such as cleaning solutions. This position will also be exposed to tight spaces such as mobile food units, walk in coolers and storage rooms.

PHYSICAL SKILL:

Requires the ability to make coordinated gross motor movements in response to changing external stimuli within moderately demanding tolerances; or the ability to make coordinated eye/hand movements on a patterned response space within low tolerance demands with no real speed requirements.

MISCELLANEOUS:

All duties and responsibilities may not be included in the above job description. Performs related work as required.
