Job Title: **Transportation Planner III**

Pay Grade: 23

### **GENERAL SUMMARY:**

The position requires advanced transportation professional planning experience of heightened complexity and variety. Some functions are similar to those of the Transportation Planner II; however the Transportation Planner III is more significantly involved with larger, more complex transportation planning projects or assignments. It exercises greater independence and judgment, receiving only general guidance from supervisors or managers.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Presents detailed reports or studies to community groups, government agencies, stakeholders, and the public.
- Consults, or assists in consulting, with community groups, government agencies, stakeholders, and appointed officials in the development and implementation of regulations, plans, projects, or programs.
- Presents detailed reports or studies to government bodies, organizations, and the public.
- Coordinates the development of studies in support of new or updated plans, programs, projects, or regulations.
- Writes formal and technical reports, planning documents, grants, and correspondences.
- Reviews project proposals of heightened complexity for compliance with applicable regulations or standards.
- Provides technical assistance and professional support in the administration of specific transportation planning programs, regulations, grants, or projects.
- Researches and compiles information on a variety of planning issues from multiple sources in order to formulate policy recommendations.
- Prepares maps and other graphical representations of data of varying complexity.
- Works closely with the public on transportation planning programs, requirements, or projects.
- Create and maintain data in Geographical Information System and other database formats.

### **SPECIFICATIONS:**

#### **KNOWLEDGE:**

Requires well-developed knowledge of planning principles, practices, and policies; as well as in-depth knowledge within one or more planning specialties. Knowledge of this level is typically obtained through experience and a Bachelor's degree in Urban Planning, Transportation Planning, Civil Engineering, Geography, Public Policy or an equivalent in-depth specialized training program that is directly related to the type of work being performed.

#### **EXPERIENCE:**

Six years of progressively responsible planning experience required, with at least two years of professional transportation planning experience.

A Master's degree in Urban Planning, Transportation Planning, Civil Engineering, Geography, Public Policy or closely related field may be substituted for two years of experience.

## **SPECIFICATIONS (cont'd):**

### **COMPLEXITY:**

Work requires the direct application of a variety of procedures, policies, and/or precedents. Advanced analytic ability is required in applying guidelines, policies and procedures, and in adapting standard methods to fit facts and conditions.

### **IMPACT OF ACTIONS:**

Errors in work typically lead to minor inconvenience and costs. Work is typically performed under limited supervision with standard operating procedures. The incumbent functions under general review and at times autonomously, with the supervisor available to answer more difficult questions.

### **SUPERVISION EXERCISED:**

#### **Direct Supervision:**

#### **Indirect Supervision:**

### **CONTACTS:**

#### **Internal Contacts:**

Level of internal contact is primarily with professionals and supervisors. Interaction requires moderate tact and cooperation; e.g., answering questions, resolving problems and/or obtaining necessary information.

#### **External Contacts:**

Level of external contact is primarily with citizens, visitors, and/or mid-level representatives of government agencies, guests, vendors and professional contacts with allied organizations. Interaction requires moderate tact and cooperation; e.g., answering questions, resolving problems and/or obtaining necessary information.

### **PHYSICAL EFFORT:**

The position occasionally requires stooping or bending. Occasional very light lifting, such as three or four reams of papers or books (up to 20 pounds or an equivalent weight) may be required.

### **WORK ENVIRONMENT:**

There are occasional minor discomforts from exposure to less-than-optimal temperature and air conditions. The position may involve dealing with modestly unpleasant situations, as with occasional exposure to office chemicals and/or extensive use of a video display terminal.

### **PHYSICAL SKILL:**

Requires the ability to make coordinated gross motor movements in response to changing external stimuli within moderately demanding tolerances; or the ability to make coordinated eye/hand movements on a patterned response space within low tolerance demands with no real speed requirements.

All duties and responsibilities may not be included in the above job description.
