

## How to Login to Benefitplace as a Retiree or Survivor

Please follow the steps outlined below to login to Benefitplace as a Retiree or Survivor.

How to login to Benefitplace for the First Time		
1	Visit <u>https://benefitplace.houstontx.gov/</u> .	
2	Click on the Can't access your account link.	
3	Select I can't remember my password, then Next.

4	<ul> <li>Enter your username (COHBEN + Your 8-Digit Employee ID) into the Username field. Check the box next to I'm not a robot. Select Next to continue.</li> <li>Note: The Employee ID you enter must be 8 digits. Add enough zeros in front of your Employee ID to make it 8 digits. E.g. 00123456 or 00012345. If you cannot remember your Employee ID, contact your benefits administrator.</li> </ul>
