COMPLAINT OF WAGE THEFT

I hereby submit this Complaint of Wage Theft to the Office of Inspector General of the City of Houston. I have read the City's "wage theft ordinance" Chapter 15, Art. IV, of the City's Code of Ordinances (Copy viewable at http://www.houstontx.gov/codes/).

I understand that "Wage Theft" means action by an employer that, with intent to avoid payment of any wages for a service that the employer knows is provided only for compensation, intentionally or knowingly secures the performance of the service by agreeing to provide compensation and, after the service is rendered, fails to make payment after receiving notice demanding payment. In no event shall wage theft be interpreted to include a dispute over wage rates. Wage is defined below¹.
