SB 1152/HB 3535's Impact on Houston

What it does:

• SB 1152/HB 3535 allows companies that currently pay both cable franchise fees telecommunication access line fees to pay a municipality only the greater of the two amounts.

Why it's unconstitutional:

- The Texas constitution expressly prohibits public property to be used by private entities for less than market value.
- By allowing providers and franchise holders to pay only one of their two fees, SB 1152/HB 3535 forces cities to make an unconstitutional "gift" of public property.
- Some companies could be able to use a city's right-of-way without ANY compensation to the public.
 - o If their statewide cable fees are greater than their statewide telecom fees, Grande Communications will provide ZERO compensation to Houstonians for their use of public right-of-way, even though they operate as a telecom provider throughout the city.

How it hurts Texas cities:

- Houston stands to lose anywhere between \$17 and \$27 million dollars annually.
- Dallas may lose up to \$9 million.
- Texas cities spend billions of dollars each year maintaining the public right-of-way for health, safety, and the benefit of all who use it.
- Any reduction in public right-of-way compensation is an illegal gift of public property and threat to the public right-of-way as well as the residents, cities, and companies that use it.
