

The Alief Forest Area Flood Mitigation Project will reconfigure Boone and Hackberry Parks to serve as multi-functional facilities that detain stormwater to reduce impacts on surrounding neighborhoods located in the 100-year floodplain and provide improved park space and amenities. These amenities include recreational detention fields which, combined, can achieve nearly 40 acre-feet of detention volume and additional green infrastructure, such as habitat for wetlands and native vegetation, that will slow the movement of stormwater and improve stormwater quality, among other ecosystem services.
