


FACT SHEET: NATURALIZATION FISCAL YEAR 2016


971,242 people applied for citizenship in 2016. There was a 24 percent spike in citizenship applications over 2015 and a 9.2 percent spike in citizenship applications over 2012, the last federal election year.

NPNA member organizations across the country completed 452 citizenship workshops in 2016, engaged over 1,000,000 potential applicants through communications and outreach, and directly assisted over 30,000 applicants.

NPNA doubled down in Colorado, Florida, Nevada, North Carolina, and Virginia/DC. In those states 197,416 people applied for citizenship and there was a 32.9 percent spike in applications over 2015, outpacing the national spike.
