Sequently Asked Questions	
1.	What categorizes as a functioning or non-functioning firearm, rifle, shotgun,
	handgun and fully automatic rifle?
٠	An unserviceable firearm is a firearm that is incapable of discharging a shot by the
	action of an explosive and is incapable of being readily restored to a firing condition.
٠	A rifle is a gun, especially one fired from shoulder level, having a long spirally
	grooved barrel.
٠	A shotgun is a long-barreled firearm designed to shoot a straight-walled cartridge
	known as a shotshell, which usually discharges numerous small pellet-like spherical
	sub-projectiles called shot, or sometimes a single solid projectile called a slug.
٠	A fully automatic firearm an auto-loading firearm that continuously chambers and fire
	rounds when the trigger mechanism is actuated.
2.	Does the firearm need to be functioning in order to participate?
٠	No.
3.	May I turn in more than one firearm?
٠	Yes, you may turn in as many firearms as possible.
4.	May I have someone else drop off my firearm(s)?
٠	Yes, however the gift card(s) will be handed over to the resident who turned in the
	firearm.
5.	How long is my VISA/Mastercard gift card activated for?
٠	Each gift card will be active for 12 months.
6.	What are the limits per person for the program?
٠	None.
7.	Will I need to show my ID?
٠	No. No identification or Government ID will be needed or shown to participate.
8.	Do I need to be a Houston resident to participate?
٠	No. No ID is required, so residency will not be checked.
9.	Does my immigration status affect my ability to participate?
•	No
10	. What happens to the firearms after they are collected?
٠	All firearms will be checked to see if they are stolen or used in any crimes. They will then be
	destroyed.
11	. Will I be able to participate by turning in my ammunition?
•	Yes, you will be able to participate in turning in your ammunition, however no monetary value
	will be given as the gift cards only apply to firearms.
