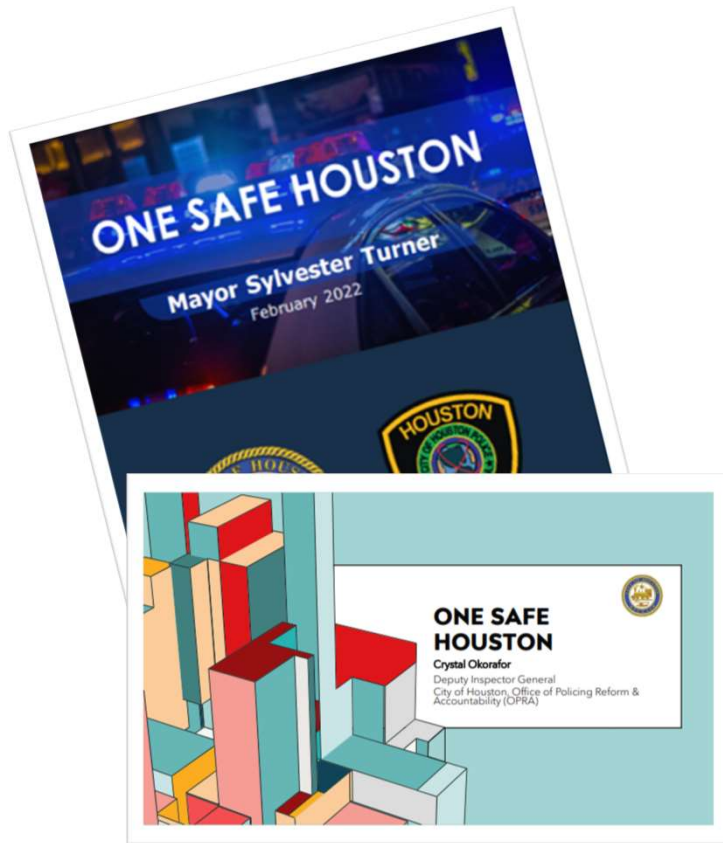

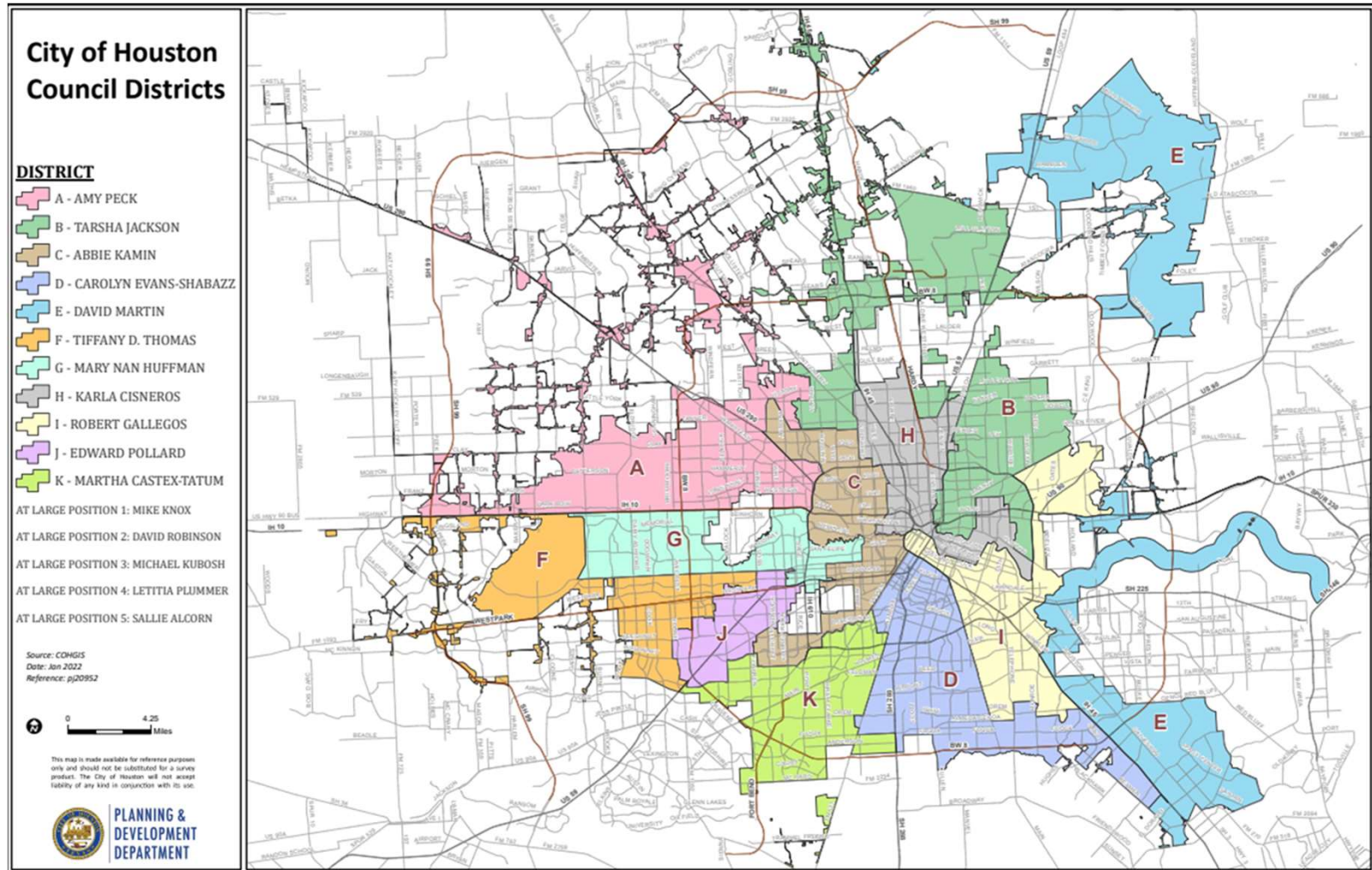
Because of the hard work of our police department and the support of our Mayor and City Council, HPD **continues to report reductions** in every category of violent crime in 2023.
