3.	Flock Camera Update Emailed by Sergeant Christian Dorton, Houston Police Department	The cameras have been an amazing tool in assisting officers in proactive arrests. Without these cameras, chances for leads would be severely limited—gratitude for the partnership. Mark Fairchild requested more quantifiable objective data from HPD as it pertains to flock cameras in the WPBD area
4.	WOW Roundabout Project	 WOW Roundabout Renovation is an estimated 10k per sign Camp Logan & Woodcrest. Two lighting sculptures will need electrical updates, will need to find out who maintains the electric bill. Third sculpture's last estimates were 150k from the same artist. HPW approved ParkHouston to manage this project, they are looking into the city contracts to see what vendors are available. ParkHouston will search for an HPW contract with sufficient allocations. Mark Fairchild to send insurance contact. ParkHouston will forward quotes and work with PBD insurance on the Camp Logan sculpture. Pending on artist's scope for lighting
