Sunday, May 6 - 8:30 a.m.

"Warbler Walk"

Several species of beautiful warblers nest in Lake Houston Park, including hooded, northern parula, yellow-throated, prothonotary, Kentucky, and others. Join the group for a guided walk in search of these beautiful avian gems. Warbler Walk is open to ages 13 and up and is FREE with \$3 park entry fee.

Saturday, May 12 - 9:00 a.m. "Off the Beaten Path Tour"

Take a guided tour to several remote locations not often seen by park visitors. Bring your cameras, binoculars, and field guides for this very popular tour! This program is by reservation only. Lake Houston Park is located 30 minutes north of downtown Houston off of Highway 59 and FM 1485, at 22031 Baptist Encampment Road. It has approximately 5,000 acres of forest, 12 miles of hike and bike trails, and 8 miles of equestrian trails and camping facilities. The park offers a variety of activities for visitors to experience.
