The Houston Parks and Recreation Department (HPARD) will hold a \$2 plant sale on September 6 - September 7 to clear the flower beds of the Houston Garden Centerat Hermann Park (1500 Hermann Dr, Houston, TX 77030). The sale will provide new homes for plants at the center prior to the start of construction at the site.

"We are inviting gardeners in Houston to find new homes for the many plants that have made the Houston Garden Center such a wonderful site for so many years," said Joe Turner Director, Houston Parks and Recreation Department. "We know that over the years the gardens have been the backdrop for many a wedding, family outing or gardeners stroll. We hope that Houston gardeners will help preserve some of those memories by providing new homes for the plants and take a bit of Hermann Park home with them."

Gardeners interested in participating in the sale will need to dig and transport their own plants on each day of the sale. They are advised to bring their own gloves, shovels, hand trowels, wheelbarrows and containers for the plants. No plants will be held for gardeners. Pick axes, axes, or power towels will not be allowed. HPARD WILL NOT have tools available for loan.

HPARD Horticulture staff will be available for advice and plant identification purposes only. Plants are priced at \$2 each plant and this isa CASH ONLY SALE. No checks, money orders, debit or credit cards will be accepted. Only shrubs and perennials inside the fenced area of the Houston Garden Center at Hermann Park are included in this sale. Trees, signs, bricks, plaques, soil, etc. WILL NOT BE SOLD.
