Day Fee: \$3.00 per person – Ages 13 thru 64 Individual Pass: \$25.00 – Admits pass holder & 3 guests for 1 year Group Pass: \$60.00 – Admits up to 50 people in a group for 1 year

PARK RULES

- All persons must check in at Gate House located at 25840 FM 1485
- Alcohol is prohibited in park; persons found violating this rule may be asked to leave the park without refund of any fees they have paid
- Quiet time is from 10 pm to 6 am, no amplified music
- The use of clotheslines is not allowed
- No gathering of firewood is permitted
- Firewood may be purchased at the Gate House (\$5.00 per bundle)
- Fires are to be built only in designated fire rings
 - Burning trash in fire rings is prohibited
- Park in designated areas only. Parking along the road or in grass areas is prohibited.
 - No more than two vehicles are allowed per camp site; automobiles with trailers count as two vehicles
 - Additional vehicles may unload at campsites but must be moved to a designated parking area after unloading is completed
- Camp in designated areas only
- The use of generators and other gasoline powered equipment is prohibited
- Extension cord use is allowed only within the confines of pavilions or buildings
 - Ensure that all appliances plugged into extension cords are attended during use
 - Please do not leave extension cords plugged in when not in use as this is a common area
- Pavilions and water tables are for community use
- All pets must be kept on a leash.
 - Do not leave pets unattended in vehicles, or anytime
 - Be considerate of others by picking up and disposing of your pet's waste
- Do not feed, harass or harm wildlife at the park
- Do not destroy park property by carving, burning, etc. this includes all facilities, amenities and natural resources
- The use of metal detectors and artifact hunting is prohibited
- No BBQ grills allowed on the overlook
