2021 SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

The Houston Parks and Recreation Department 2021 Summer Enrichment Program will operate at twenty of our larger Community Centers from June 14, 2021 – August 20, 2021. The program will operate with one staff member for every eight children, Monday through Friday from 8:00 am – 6:00 pm for ages 6-13. The cost for the program is \$30 per week per child with fee exemptions available for qualified persons.

These measures are based on guidance from the Centers for Disease Control, National Recreation and Parks Association, Open Texas Minimum Standard Health Protocols for Day Youth Camp Operations and Staff, and the City of Houston AP 3-39, Access to City Buildings or Facilities During a Medical Epidemic or Pandemic.
