

Description


East Houston is a collection of neighborhoods in the northeastern part of the city. The name is taken from an old subdivision located just off what was then the highway to Beaumont; most of that old town site remains undeveloped. The community is made up largely of single family homes in standard suburban tract subdivisions. The area remains generallywooded, especially close to Halls Bayou, where a City of Houston golf course, Brock Park, is found. A major industrial park, Railwood, is located in the southeast corner of the community adjacent to a major land fill.




