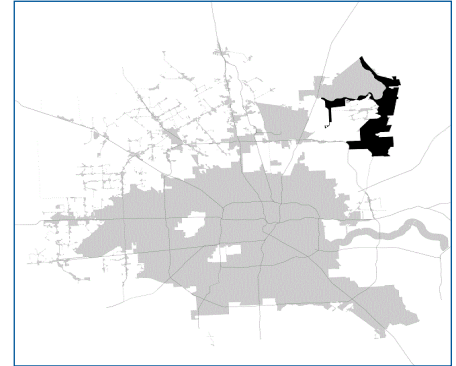

Description

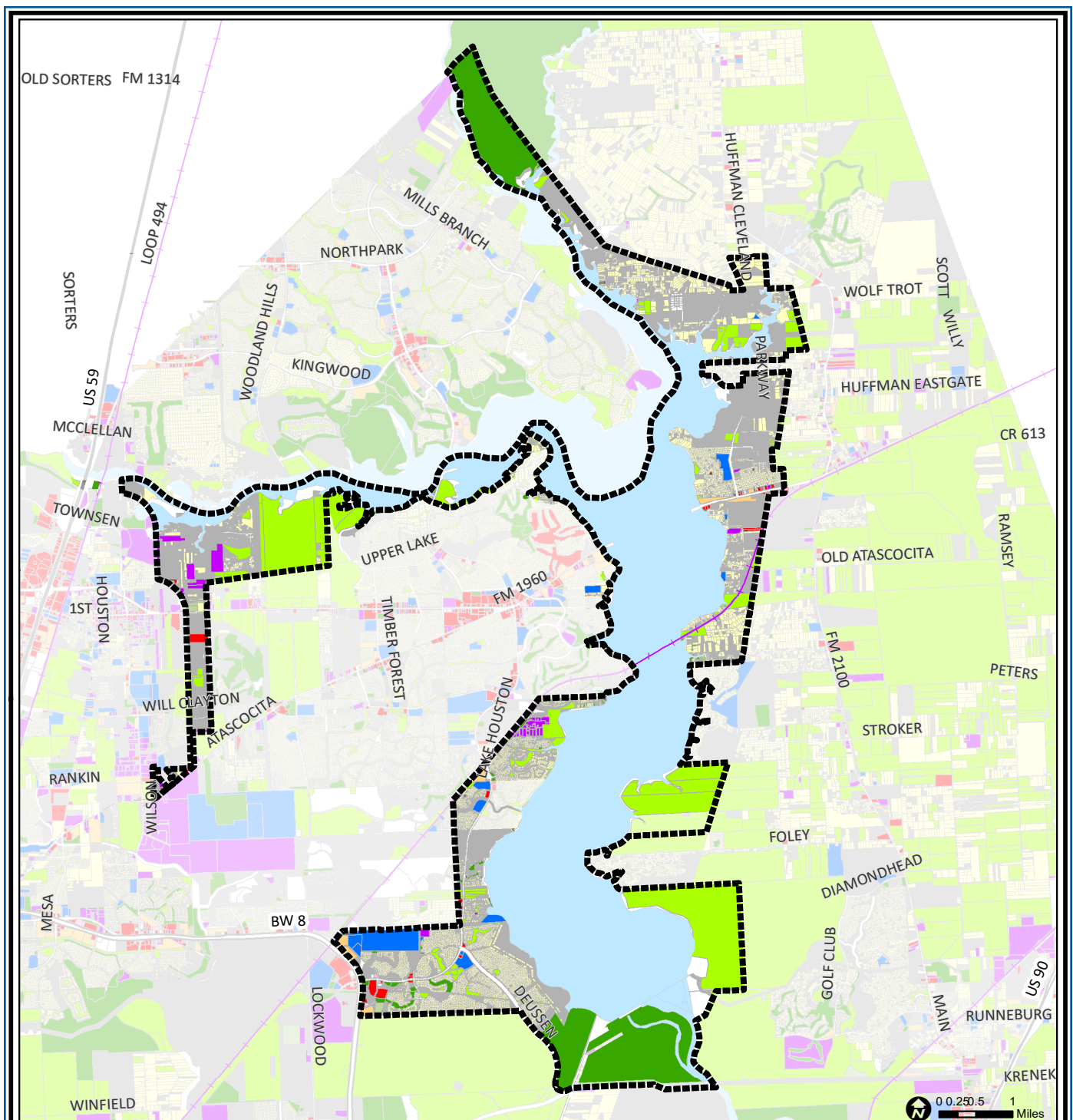
Lake Houston super neighborhood is located adjacent to the east side of the City's primary water reservoir, Lake Houston. The majority of the population in this area resides in the Lakewood Heights, single-family subdivision. In 1965, the subdivisions immediately adjacent to the lake were annexed to the City and provided with City sewer services. Lake Houston includes a number of lakeside homes, which are part of the master-planned community of Atascosita. The area is within the Huffman ISD.

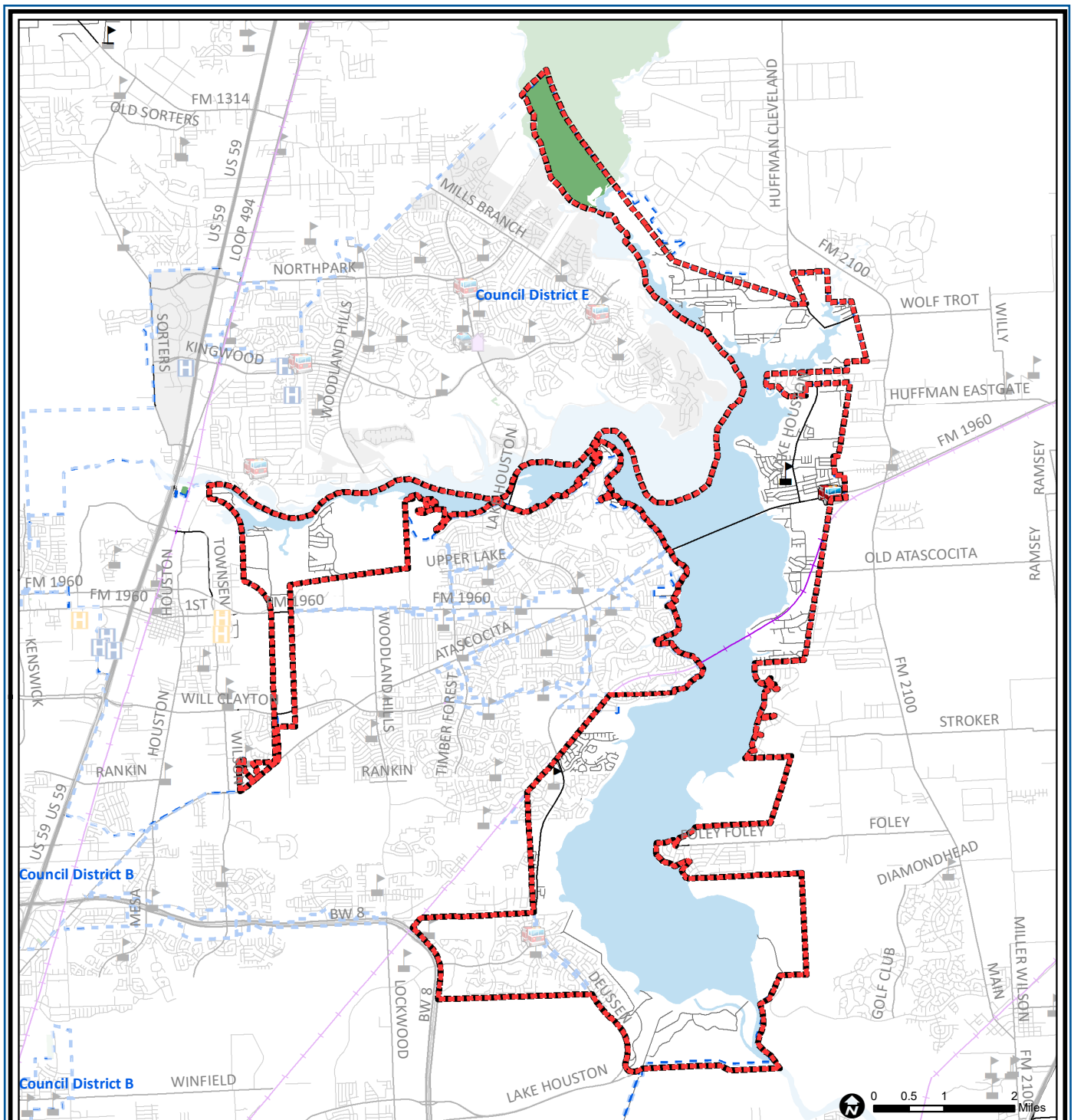

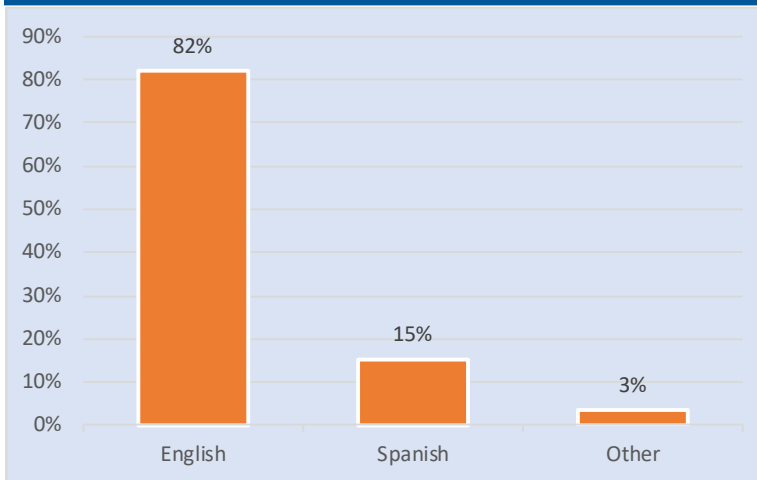
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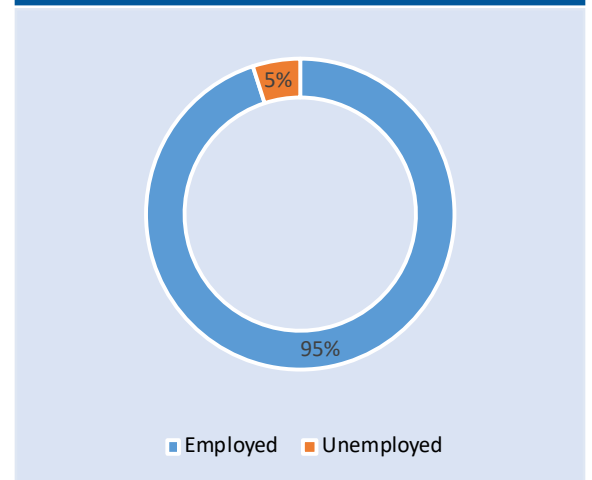


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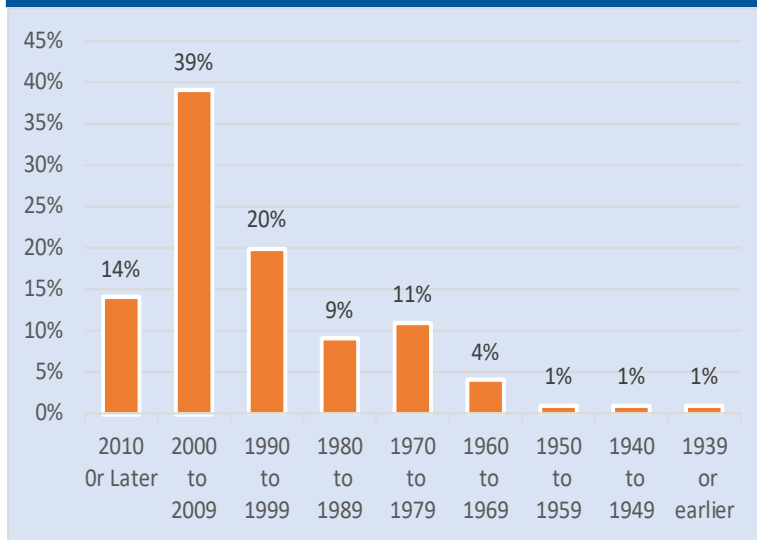
Language Spoken at Home



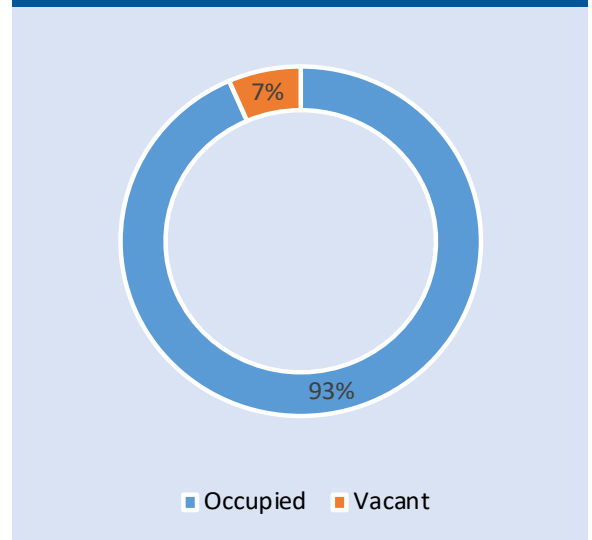
Employment Status
