
2012 Median Home Value Top Ten Populous Counties in the US

Median Home Value Top Ten Populous Counties in the US: 2012



- The U.S. Census Bureau recently released its Median Home Values for 2012 Cities, Counties and Metropolitan Statistical Areas.
- Median Home Value means that one-half of all homes were worth more and on-half were worth less.
- Median Home Values are in current dollars.
- Harris County (\$131,000) ranks 9th among the top ten populous counties in the US, followed by Dallas County (\$128,000).
- Among the top ten counties with highest Median Home Values, two counties are in New York, followed by three counties in California.
- Kings County's median (\$556,300) value is three times higher than the US (\$174,600) and four times higher than the Harris county value (\$131,000).
